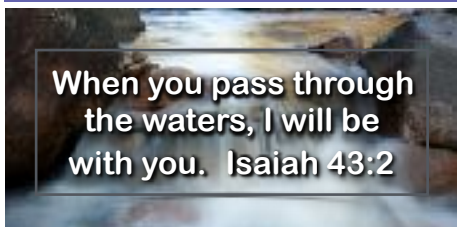

Seems like each year at this time, we need to send up an alert about our giving. At the end of May, we have given \$192,720.11 for 2018. Our expenses have been \$231,725.50. We are behind for the year by \$38,935.39. Yes, that is a lot, and so this is an alert for all West Mainers to make sure their giving is up-to-date. We had a fantastic West Main Mission Offering this year and all our normal spending patterns are in place; it is just cash flow mostly. Billie Jo will be sending out mid-year statements soon, so take a look at yours and let's rebalance our budget over the next couple of months. Great. Thanks!
