Because of your generous support at the event, along with several donations made in advance, we raised over a thousand dollars! This has resulted in each student receiving a hundred dollars toward their trip expenses. This is INCREDIBLE and I can't thank everyone enough!

For those who weren't able to make it to the fundraiser or haven't yet heard, the youth will be traveling to Puerto Rico for this year's Passport summer camp! I already know what you're thinking: "Puerto Rico? What a fun mission trip!" or "Puerto Rico? They're taking a vacation!" This trip isn't a mission trip or a vacation, although there are certainly going to be service projects and we may or may not visit a beach one of the days we're there.


Instead, think of Passport Puerto Rico as a cultural enrichment adventure. This camp will be an equal mix of stateside churches, students, chaperones, and staff, alongside Puerto Rican churches, students, chaperones, and staff. Our activities - such as worship, Bible studies, games, and more - will be in both English and Spanish. The focus of this trip is for students to recognize that our faith is impacted by our culture, and how others practice their faith may be different but no less valuable. In fact, the greatest gift will be learning from each other!

Passport Puerto Rico is bound to be a formative trip for our youth group. **If you'd like to further support this great opportunity, our next fundraiser is on Sunday, March 15th.** The youth will be serving a lasagna lunch directly after West Main's worship service and donations are encouraged! 
